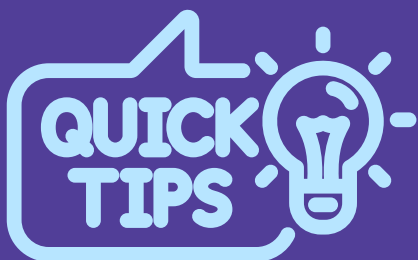
## FACULTY & STAFF:

Free with COVA and all insurances that cover the flu shot 100% or \$30 through Student Health Services.

## STUDENTS:

\$30 shots offered with a Mason student ID (Free with AETNA student health insurance plan.)

- No walks ins. Appointments only.
- Complete your Mason Covid Health Check.
- Bring your insurance card, completed vaccine consent form, and wear a mask. Wear a short sleeve shirt.
- Plan to spend 10 -15 minutes after your shot to ensure there is no adverse reaction.

# FLU SHOT CLINIC FAQs FOR FACULTY AND STAFF

## Do I need to register to receive a flu shot?

Yes, please book your appointment in advance of the clinic. No walk-ins will be accepted so that we can follow proper safety precautions.

## What safety measures are you taking for COVID-19 at the flu shot clinic?

The safety of faculty and staff is of utmost importance so we are taking the following precautions:

- Requiring appointments to allow for proper social distancing.
- Asking everyone to complete paperwork in advance and bring it with them to minimize use of tables and pens.
- Requiring masks and evidence of Mason COVID health check. Pharmacists will also ask a few health questions before administering shots.
- Wiping down surfaces at the clinic after use

## Are there forms I should complete beforehand?

### What should I bring?

Yes, please complete the flu shot consent form, your respective health insurance card, evidence that you took the COVID daily health check, a mask, and wear a short sleeve shirt.

## Who administers the flu shots?

Harris Teeter pharmacists administer the flu shots to faculty and staff.

## FAQS CONTINUED

### **If I do not have Mason's health insurance, can I receive a flu shot?**

Most insurances cover the flu shot, but it is not guaranteed. You may ask [worklife@gmu.edu](mailto:worklife@gmu.edu) before booking your appointment. You may alternatively receive your flu shot from Student Health Services for \$30.

### **How long do I need to stay after I receive my flu shot?**

The pharmacists advise waiting for 10 -15 minutes after the flu shot to monitor for any adverse reaction. We will have a clean area where you can wait at a safe social distance.

### **I have Kaiser Permanente, can I get my flu shot at the clinic?**

You can find a Kaiser Permanent location for shots at [kp.org/flu](http://kp.org/flu) or get your shot from Student Health Services for \$30.

### **Will thimerosal-free vaccines be provided?**

Yes, please let the pharmacist know you need this option.
